- \$10.00 trip fee<sup>2</sup> is all-inclusive: transportation, meals, snacks, entrance fee, prizes, t-shirt and more.
- Trip will be chaperoned by local teachers and AAUW members.
- A chartered bus will pick up girls at two locations: 7:15 am at the Johannesburg-Lewiston Area School parking lot and 8:00 am at the Gaylord Middle School parking lot.
